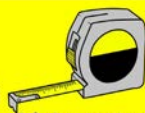

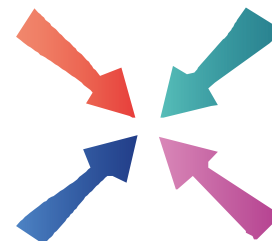

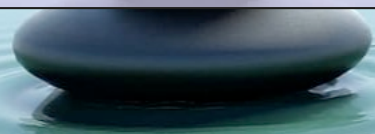

Village People: Laura Orna



Some local villagers will know Laura, as she is the new Clerk to the Governors at Olveston CEVC Primary School, having taken on the role 12 months ago. Before this she had served on the allotment committee and was a secretary and trustee of the Bristol Family Centre for the support of Deaf Children, as well as being on the committee of the Bristol Deaf Children's Society. Safe to say she is a real contributor to whatever community she belongs to!

Laura was born in Solihull but moved around quite a lot as her father worked for the MOD. However, most of her school years, (primary, secondary and sixth form) were spent in Cheltenham. In her childhood Laura was a keen horse rider and wanted to be a professional eventer. Although she has retained her love of riding, an accident a few years ago, which caused some mild spinal damage, means that she no longer risks riding.

After leaving school she worked in care home for several years, before studying nursing at UWE and qualifying as a Registered General Nurse in 2012. Whilst she was studying, she also worked part-time at a care home for people with learning difficulties. It was here that she met her husband, Henry, who was working there as a support worker. Laura says he followed her into nursing and Henry is now a qualified mental health nurse, for an agency based in Gloucester. Had Laura always wanted to be in nursing? Well, the answer is no..... she actually wanted to be a teacher and started studying English Language at Plymouth University but says that she soon found that it wasn't for her, so changed to nursing.

Laura's first job, after qualifying, was at a care home in Winterbourne. After that, she worked on the neurosurgery post operative wards at Frenchay Hospital including the high dependency unit. When the new Southmead Hospital opened, she transferred to the intensive care unit working with patients from both neurological surgery and other intensive care needs. She took maternity leave from there, but the shift patterns didn't help with the challenges of bringing up a baby, so moved to a role in pre-op assessment, still at Southmead Hospital, for 8 years. From there she moved to Emersons Green hospital, working on the surgical wards. Although she no longer has a

Tockington's Hidden History: The Eye Well

The Eye Well, St Michael's Well or Miles Well, are different names for the same well located on the verge of Upper Tockington Road, close to Westfield but today hidden from sight by overgrowth. The Ordnance Survey of 1881 called it St Michael's Well. According to our late local historian, Eric Garrett, it was named after the chapel attached to the original Manor at Tockington, both now lost. By 1903, however, the OS map described it as Miles Well. It lies in an interesting position on the boundary between the two villages. The map also records the discovery, in 1867, of human remains at nearby Westfield Cottage. Interestingly, pre-Christian burials were often sited near holy wells and boundaries.

The plot thickens - in the Tockington Court Roll of 1794, William Clarke was presented (accused) "*for encroachment of the Lord's Waste near Miles Pool.....and we order him to lay open the same before next Court under penalty of 5 shillings.*" William Clarke was presented for similar offences over the next 5 years. It appears he had enclosed the piece of waste land where Miles Well stood, presumably to include it in the adjacent field. So, we have use of the name Miles at least for the locality, if not for the well itself. Who was Miles? Miles is the Latin name for Knight and might therefore refer to the Lord of the Manor ie "the Lord's well on the Lord's waste".

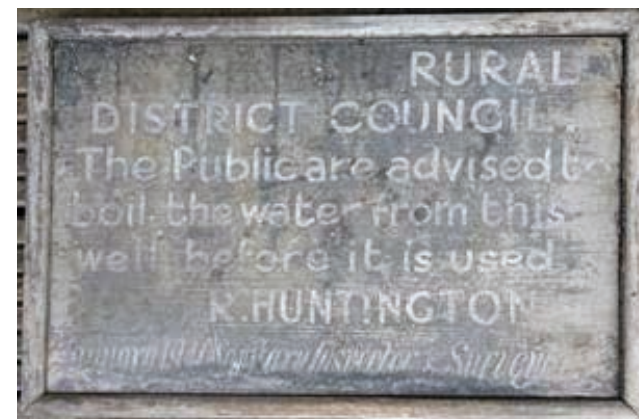

The most common name for the well is the Eye Well. It could be a corruption of Michael's or Miles Well but certainly there are many testimonies to the soothing properties of the water on the eyes. About forty years ago, Mr Farr of The Elms Farm, just below the well, recalled, "My father in the early 1900s had an accident with quick lime which went into his eyes. It was reckoned that the quick application of the well's water and subsequent use, saved his eyesight. My brother, 50 years ago, had a very bad sty come on his eye when he was in London. He came home with this sty in full spate. Within 24 hours of bathing with well water it was gone."



Hilda Meachin (nee Dyer) also remembered... "Myself and younger brother Jack, developed badly inflamed eyes known locally as Pink Eye (probably conjunctivitis). We lived next door to The Fox Inn at Old Down, and my mother would walk down to the Eye Well, fill bottles with

the water to bathe our eyes. The stinging sensation and inflammation was soon cured.....I also remember we were not allowed to drink from the well unlike the sparkling (water from the) Rams Well, also in Tockington."

How long ago the water was drinkable is not known, but it is clear that the old Sentinel steam lorries working from the quarries (in the early part of the 20th century) used the well water and polluted it with oil. In the 1930s the Eye Well and Rams Well were looked after by a Bill Gardener for £1 a year from the Parish Council. He recalled that the "Eye Well was surrounded on three sides with stone walls with a corrugated iron roof sloping towards Olveston to keep the leaves out. The well was entered via a wooden gate and there were two steps down to a fairly small hole from which the water could be scooped up." Nick Fear, recounting Eric Garrett, added there was a large stone slab below the steps and that the only light was from the doorway.

In the late 1940s the gate was broken and the Parish Council were concerned that someone might get drowned there. In the 1950s the water was condemned as unfit to drink unless boiled and the well was infilled with hardcore. It seems a pity that such an interesting parish feature has been lost.

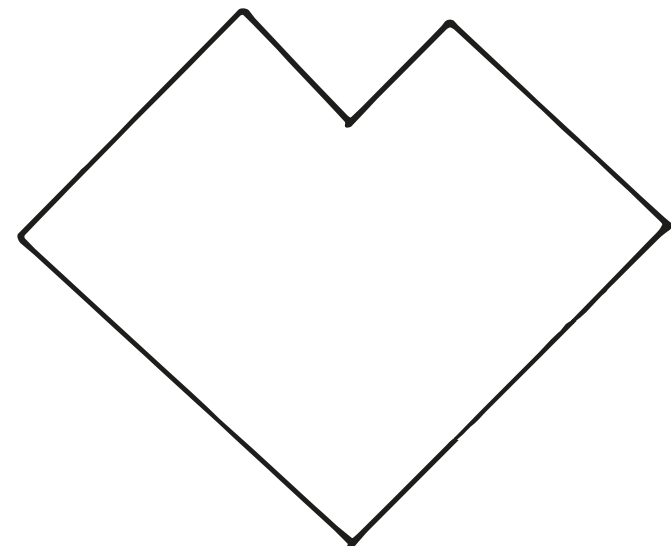
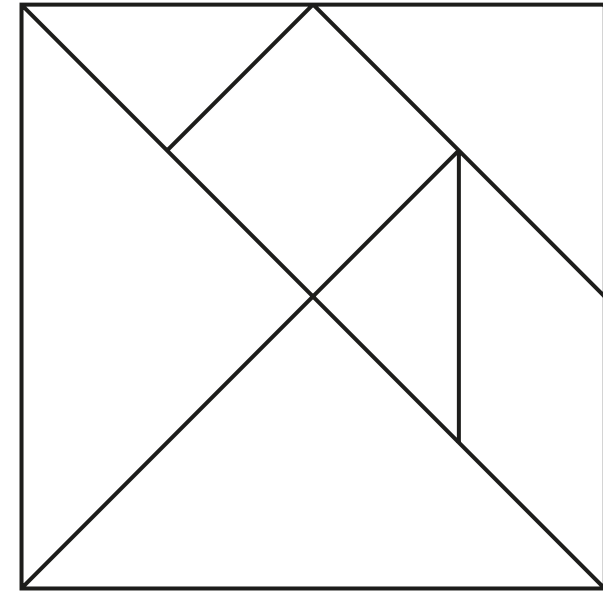

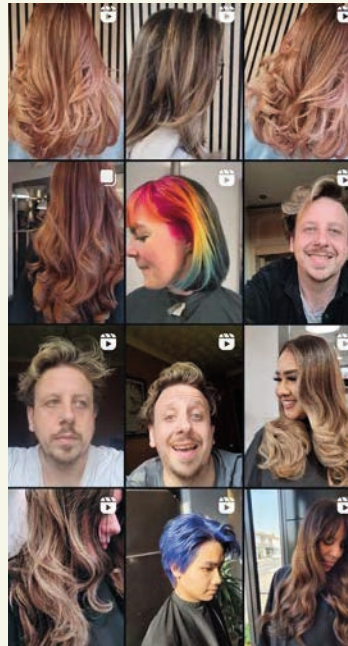

February Facts*

So here we are in February. My internet research tells me that at one time this was the last month of the Roman calendar and a time of ritual purification by washing. It is, of course, the shortest month of the year and the last month of winter in the Northern Hemisphere.

In Ireland, the festival of Imbloc is being revived by traditionalists. This is one of the four Gaelic traditional seasonal festivals and celebrates the onset of spring. Imbloc has traditionally been celebrated on 1st February, however it appears that the timing of the festival was originally more flexible and based on seasonal changes such as lambing or the flowering of the blackthorn. It was a festival of the hearth and home, and a celebration of the lengthening days and the early signs of spring. Celebrations often involved special foods, candles or a bonfire if the weather permitted. The lighting of candles and fires represented the return of warmth and the increasing power of the Sun over the coming months and hopes for a good harvest.



In America February is designated as National Bird Feeding month which strikes me as rather a good idea. February 1st is – believe it or not – National Baked Alaska Day. Then there is Groundhog Day on February 2nd. According to folklore, if it is cloudy when a groundhog emerges from its burrow on this day, then the spring season will arrive early; if it is sunny, the groundhog will supposedly see its shadow and retreat back into its den,

and winter weather will persist for six more weeks. Many people will be familiar with the idea of Groundhog Day thanks to the 1993 film starring Bill Murray as an arrogant weatherman.

Valentine's Day, February 14th, is, of course, a very well-known commercially driven celebration. While the custom of sending cards, flowers, chocolates and other gifts originated in the UK, Valentine's Day still remains connected with various regional customs in England. In Norfolk, a character called 'Jack' Valentine knocks on the rear door of houses leaving sweets and presents for children.

And finally, February 17th is Shrove Tuesday, the day before Ash Wednesday and the beginning of Lent. It's also known as Pancake Day and making pancakes on Shrove Tuesday was a way to use up ingredients like eggs, fats and milk that were not allowed during Lent. Shrove Tuesday gets its name from the ritual of shriving, i.e. the process of confessing and repenting of sins by fasting and abstaining from luxuries during Lent.

What are PFAs?

PFAs are a group of 10,000 substances that are widely used for their water heat and stain resistant properties and are informally known as forever chemicals.

PFAs came into use with the invention of Teflon in 1938 to make fluoropolymer coatings. They were then introduced for use in a wide variety of products including waterproof fabric, yoga pants, carpets, shampoo, mobile phone

screens, wall paint, furniture, pots and pans, adhesives, food, firefighting foam, electrical insulation and cosmetics.

Residues from these chemicals move through soil and water and bioaccumulate in food sources such as fish, which are then ingested by the general population, while occupational exposure occurs through accidental ingestion, inhalation and skin contact in industrial and work settings. Exposure to PFAs has been linked to many diseases and health conditions in humans. The first research study to report elevated organic fluorine levels in the blood of fluorochemical workers was published in 1900. If our blood was tested today, it would undoubtedly show PFAs were present.

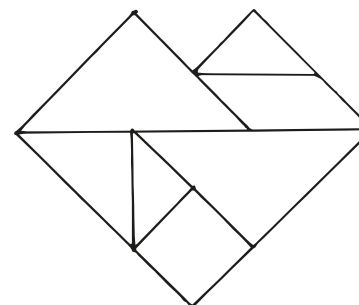

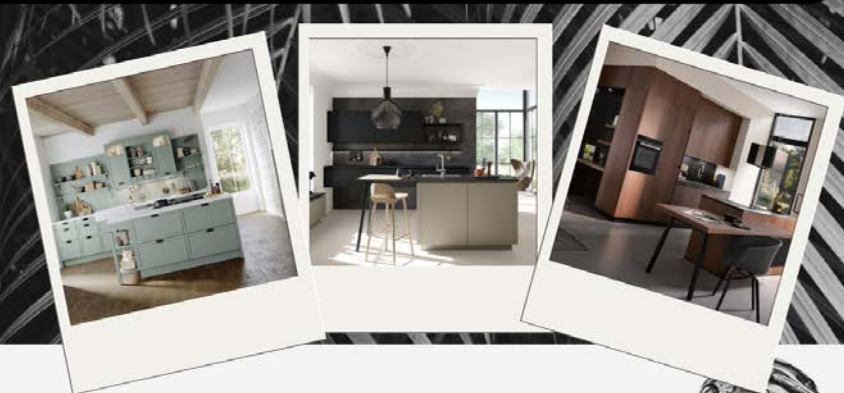
