

The Cross Circle on Tockington Green

The stone circle which appears on our front cover this month is a familiar sight, however many of us know very little – or nothing – about it. This article is adapted from the one we included last time this cover illustration was used (March 2020). Local historian, the late Eric Garret, researched and wrote the following back in May 2001.

It is unknown when the 'Stone Cross Circle' built with local limestone and located on the village green, was erected. It is assumed to be associated with a Free Chapel (possibly on the Mustay land) that existed in Tockington between the 12th and 16th centuries. The Green at this period would have comprised the full triangle. (House development occurred from the 18th century.) The Chapel was possibly founded by Symon Fitz Pons and ended in the ownership of the Berkeley family. The last incumbent of the chapel took retirement in 1548, when Bristol Cathedral dioceses were being created.

The Cross circle comprises two diameters, the lower diameter is 24½ feet and the upper diameter is 23½ feet. The maximum height above ground is 3½ feet; this varies due to sloping ground. The average height from lower large diameter to top of the smaller diameter is 2¼ feet. The Cross probably had two functions, one for religious purposes as the lower circle was suitable for kneeling and the top stones for elbow resting. Its second purpose was used as a market cross; Fairs and Markets were held on The Green from the 13th to the late 19th century. A Fair Status was granted in 1281.

It is presumed that the circle originally supported a wooden cross and it is assumed that in the early 19th century an elm tree was planted to replace the decayed wooden cross. The tree, with several decades of branch pruning, died and was removed in 1946 when the Green, as it stands, was gifted to the parish by the Salmon family whose estate of Tockington Manor was sold at auction.

At Meeting Point, we believe that the tree now growing within the stone circle was planted by the Olveston and Tockington W.I. as part of their Diamond Jubilee celebrations in 1978. If any reader knows more about the history of this tree, or even remembers the occasion of its planting, we would love to hear from you.

Autumn and Winter Highlights

Following a hot and dry summer I felt a great deal of uncertainty about the possible impact on our local wildlife. Autumn brought very mild weather and many plants just kept flowering, and insects seemed to be having an extended season. Bees were still in the garden at the end of November. But we needed rain and of course we got it!

Wildlife in our area appeared to be doing well despite the weather. Locally, fungi seemed to be abundant and there was plenty to see - especially around Tockington Hill and in the woodlands of The Slad. I observed more fungi this year than ever before.

I have spent a lot of time in those woods this winter. In December and early January, the bird song was incredible, especially the sounds of song and mistle thrushes who were joined by our migrant winter thrushes, redwing and fieldfare. I went back several days in a row to hear them. We also had a small flock of redwing visit our garden to feed on various tree berries.

The Stride Family of Severn Beach

Robert Stride transformed Severn Beach from farmland to a successful holiday resort in the 1920s to 1950s. Uncovering Roman life on the Severn Estuary - Roman finds between Pilning and Severn Beach

Between August 2021 and October 2022, Worcestershire Archaeology stripped back over 4.5 hectares of pastureland south of Pilning, South Gloucestershire. Olveston's Round House

Travelling through country villages it is sometimes possible to find small, intriguing solitary buildings. A stout locked door gains entrance to a small room with a flag stone floor and sometimes a wooden bench. These structures have no windows, although some doors have a barred inspection hatch in them. They seem ancient and many are beautifully preserved, but their use is not always obvious.

Dating from the late eighteenth century these had many names but were commonly known as the local 'lock-up'. Anyone who was considered troublesome after drinking too much alcohol, could be placed in the lock-up to be released once they were in a more sober state. The building was open for use by any parishioner who sought to restore a disturbed peace in their village - and hopefully care for an inebriated individual. It was some decision to make as the interiors were cold, damp and the pungent smell can be imagined.

There is a fine example of a lock-up in Thornbury, which has now been incorporated into a shop, but none are evident in our local parishes. This was not, however, always the case. In Gloucester archives there is an undated account from a local woman.

'Mrs. Young, who is eighty, remembers when the 'Round House' stood near Olveston Church. It was round and without windows and was used whenever anyone was found hopelessly intoxicated. He was taken in and shut up without food or water for twenty-four hours, when he would be found, without doubt, sober. The building was situated on the south side of the church, in the road near the present war memorial and was probably removed about 1850'. A sketch was made from her description and attached to the account.



The Round House

The narrative goes on to mention Olveston Stocks which were a few yards from the Round House. These were situated outside of the south gate, on the right-hand side on leaving the churchyard. They were in existence in 1875 when a bill for repairs was presented to the parish by a J Pool.

There are no surviving records of who had occupied the Round House or stocks. Perhaps both fell into disrepair and there was no local interest in restoring them. Had the Round House survived it would certainly have been a local curiosity. It may also have blocked the way for the erection of our war memorial in 1920, which today seems to be in the perfect place.

Microplastics are small plastic pieces, less than 5 mm long, that pollute the environment. They come from cosmetics, synthetic clothing, and plastic bags packaging and bottles. They are not biodegradable, so they accumulate and persist in the environment. They pollute oceans, freshwater ecosystems and air. Microplastics have been

detected in various aquatic species, drinking water, beer, food products, and even human tissues and organs and in our bones and saliva. In 2025 eight volunteers willingly gulped down a solution of microplastics to find out where they go.

Millions of tons of plastic pollution enter oceans annually, contributing up to 30% of ocean pollution. Once in the environment they accumulate and persist. Microplastics have been found in the digestive tracts and tissues of various sea animals such as crabs mussels and fish. Sea birds are likely to mistake microplastics as food floating on the surface, which can cause them to consume less food and lose energy. Lightweight single-use plastic accounts for approximately 50 percent of all plastics produced. Kerbside collection is provided locally and at supermarkets for the collection of these plastics so that they avoid landfill. Sadly, tons of these UK plastics are shipped out to countries such as Malaysia for disposal, where there they are so swamped in the stuff they are going to return it.

In Bristol a company called Matter has developed the first filter named Regen, designed to target microplastics in washing machines. They were finalists in the Earthshot 2025 global competition. It is a breakthrough filtration technology which captures microplastics preventing them from entering our waterways.



A Note from the Severn Vale Village Agent

Attendance Allowance helps with extra costs if you have a disability or health condition severe enough that you need someone to help look after you.

Depending on the level of care you need you could get £73.90 or £110.40 a week to help with personal support if both of the following apply:

- you have a physical disability, a mental disability, or a health condition for which you have needed care for 6 months or longer
- you're State Pension age or older

You could get extra Pension Credit, Housing Benefit or Council Tax Reduction if you get Attendance Allowance. You do not have to have someone caring for you to claim.







As spring advanced in North Yorkshire, where I was born, my father would drive us out over the moors in our old Austin 7 and drop down into the steep-sided valley of Farndale. There we could view the wild daffodils, otherwise known as Lent Lilies, and which I trust blossom there still, along the banks of the River Dove.

The name Lent lilies comes from their habit of flowering in March and April and thus during Lent. They are said to symbolise renewal, hope, and new beginnings, and represent the arrival of spring and the promise of positive change.



All of which are particularly pertinent to us during Lent; those few days and weeks in which we either deny ourselves some of our pleasures or indeed dedicate ourselves to new acts of kindness. Please note - I am biased in my choice of location for Lent lilies. You don't have to travel to Yorkshire to find them. There are several places in Gloucestershire where Lent Lilies grow, you can look them up on the internet.
